This letter serves as an objection to PECO's Interrogatories and Requests for Production of Documents recently mailed to me. I have not been well the past few weeks, have had several doctors' appointments and do not have the time to respond to or get all the documents requested. I have been working full time even though I haven't been feeling well. I am in the process of getting medical documentation as well as other documents to present and I will

mail them all as soon as they are available.  
I do have a response to some of your questions.  
Because of my physical problems, specifically  
the chemical sensitivity, autoimmune diseases  
and the fact that I seem to be sensitive  
to wireless radiation, I have tried to make  
my home a haven where I can recover from  
environmental pollutants I may be exposed to  
during the day. We are wired in our home,  
do not use wireless devices in our home (we  
have a landline. We do have a microwave  
which isn't plugged in. My husband uses  
it occasionally to heat up his coffee, I  
not. When I have to use my cell phone  
when out, I text - that is what I do <sup>MAY 5 2017</sup>  
When I hold a cell phone to my ear I experience  
heat and an uncomfortable feeling so I don't  
do it frequently. Since installation of the  
gas smart meter I can say that I have  
experienced an incidence of supraventricular  
tachycardia (I am under treatment by a  
cardiologist) and have had trouble

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sleeping. Obviously there is no way to find out for sure if this is a result of the meter ~~but since~~ it hasn't been removed but it remains a possibility

I have a condition which can be life threatening, idiopathic angioedema; ~~there is no know~~ I also have an autoimmune condition. Because of these conditions in addition to my chemical sensitivity I need my home to be a haven and do not want to be bombarded with the radiation given off from smart meters which may adversely affect myself. I feel that PECO is going forward with this case is threatening my civil rights and my right as a law abiding citizen to feel safe and secure in my own home. I do have a disability and cannot be

I have requests of PECO, <sup>discriminated against</sup> for such I would like to know how many people have asked PECO not to install smart meters at their homes. I would like to know how many formal complaints have been lodged with the PUC against them. I would like to

know the status of these complaints and if PECO is not installing smart meters at these homes, I do not have the money for a lawyer and obviously would stand a better chance of pleading my case if I did but if there are people who are fighting this with lawyers, and if PECO is currently not installing smart meters at these homes it would not be fair to penalize me because I do not have the resources that others may have.

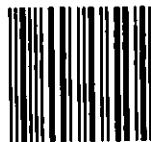
