Unopposed Request for Extension of Time

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph No. 3 of the Commission's Opinion and Order entered on March 21, 2017 ("March 21 Order") in the above-referenced proceeding, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement ("I&E") requests an extension of thirty (30) days for mediation.

The March 21 Order provides for a sixty (60) day mediation period with the option for the parties to request an additional thirty (30) days to mediate.¹ Mediator Tiffany A. Hunt issued an Interim Order Setting Resolution Conference on April 5, 2017. A mediation session was held on May 10, 2017. The sixty day mediation period is set to expire on June 5, 2017.

I&E requests an additional thirty (30) days for mediation, or until July 5, 2017, to permit Pine Roe Natural Gas Co., Inc. ("Pine Roe") sufficient time to make the necessary repairs to its facilities, file the requisite reports and pay outstanding assessments in order to achieve compliance with the Public Utility Code and the Commission's regulations. I&E's Gas Safety Division intends to schedule an inspection of Pine Roe's records and facilities on a date to be determined at the end of June 2017 to evaluate Pine Roe's compliance.

By e-mail dated May 18, 2017, Pine Roe indicated that it does not oppose I&E's request for an extension of thirty (30) additional days for mediation.
