THE OFFICE OF SMALL BUSINESS ADVOCATE**

The Small Business Advocate is authorized and directed to represent the interest of small business consumers of utility services in Pennsylvania under the provisions of the Small Business Advocate Act, Act 181 of 1988, 73 P.S. §§ 399.41 - 399.50 (the "Act"). The Act further provides that the Small Business Advocate is to issue publicly a written statement stating concisely the specific interest of small business consumers to be protected by his initiation of or intervention in any proceeding involving those interests before the Public Utility Commission (the "Commission") or any other agency or court. This public statement relates to the filing today by the Small Business Advocate of a Notice of Intervention in the proceeding commenced by the filing of the Petition of Pennsylvania-American Water Company ("PAWC" or the "Company") for Approval of Tariff Changes and Accounting and Rate Treatment Related to the Replacement of Lead Customer-Owned Service Pipes, with the Commission on May 22, 2017 ("Petition").

The Small Business Advocate files this Notice of Intervention in order to protect the interests of the Company's small business customers. A thorough inquiry by the Commission into all of the elements of the Company's Petition is necessary to ensure that the requested relief is lawful, just, reasonable, and not unduly discriminatory.

In view of the foregoing, the Small Business Advocate will participate in proceedings before the Commission to investigate the reasonableness of the Petition. The Small Business Advocate will ask the Commission to deny any tariff changes and accounting and rate treatment related to the replacement of lead customer-owned service pipes that apply to small business customers that are not proven by PAWC to be lawful, just, reasonable, and not unduly discriminatory to the Company's small business customers.
