
This letter is in response to your letter dated May 31, 2017 wherein you are filing Public Power LLC's Certificate of Satisfaction and Notice of Right to Object. I am objecting to the filing of this satisfaction and closing of this case. I intend to fully pursue a final outcome of this case through the Court system.

I had received a call on or about Wednesday, May 31, 2017 from an "Alejanbro Pagani" of Crius. Mr. Pagani offered \$500 to settle this case. At that time, I agreed; however, to date I have never received a check for this settlement. I have never received any release or satisfaction for signature of this case from Public Power. As such, I believe this is a bogus offer and I am hereby rescinding any and all offers or agreements for settlement. I fully wish to pursue this matter through the judicial system.

I am in receipt of the audio that Public Power claims to have received my permission to change my service. I have listened to this audio and it clearly has been altered. Additionally, Public Power claims to have sent a confirming letter to me. No such confirmation letter was ever received.

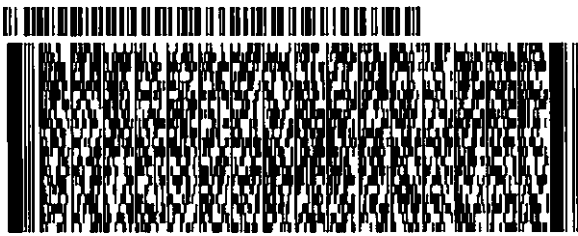

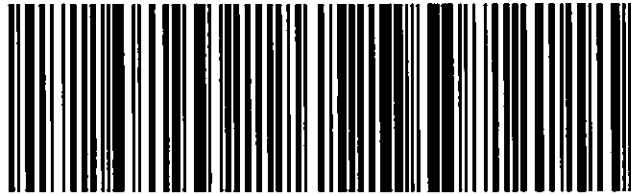
