I received a letter from Attorney Morris on June 17. As I stated in the previous info I sent, I am SORRY to report the bad effects from the smart meter installed at my home on February 14, 2017. I'd rather not be going through this and I do understand it's the law to have one. I would appreciate it if West Penn WOULD PLEASE MOVE IT FAR FROM MY HOUSE! I'm not one, at age 77, to complain unless there's good reason.

I had written about many bad effects after getting a pacemaker on May 27, 2011. That's when my system changed dramatically, which has been pretty horrible for me for many years.

Before Pacemaker

I watched TV fine I wasn't weak in my house for 20 years I listened to radio fine

could sleep by unplugged stereo fine.

Could pick up a silver chain necklace

could pick up batteries fine

AFTER Pacemaker

I had heart pain while watching TV I moved back to my house in 2013 and was very weak from dirty electricity.

In 2014, I stopped listening to the radio because the waves (radio) caused SEVERE pain in my back, below the pacemaker only, with SEVERE weakness.

I was in Afib 10 days sleeping by my UNPLUGGED stereo. I left the bedroom where the stereo was, and went out of Afib.

I picked up a silver chain necklace in my bathroom, and the electrical strip went BOOM and turned black.

The necklace burnt into in my hands (my pacemaker was working). * When I showed my cardiologist the picture, he said nothing.

I was around battery operated candles for 2 1/2 hours on December 25, 2016. After I picked up 3 batteries a few hours later - my pacemaker was out - I burned and stung on my ARMS, HEAD, NECK and EARS for hours and had heart pain for 12 hours.

I had a stroke on July 14, 2016, and lost my driving privilege at 76. It was caused by A-fib which started in April 2011 from VERY HIGH water bacteria in a rented mobile home. I didn't get to the ER for 31 hours and according to the Altoona Hospital, over 500 million brain cells should have died. THANK GOD, I can live alone as a widow, after getting home from the hospital.

I was doing quite well after the stroke until the smart meter was installed. The horrible side effects were and to some degree are: ¹awful ITCHING (I stood by my open kitchen door and talked for about two minutes and I itched SO BADLY), ²bad RASH, ³SEVERE WEAKNESS that I could hardly walk. (I turned down a colonoscopy because of the weakness) ⁴LIGHT-HEADNESS, ⁵SHORTNESS of BREATH, UNSTABLE WALKING, ⁷WHOLE BODY ACHINESS. These started the month after the meter was installed and got some better when I quit going to the front of the house to get my mail. I DO NOT HAVE A CELL PHONE, TV, COMPUTER, MICROWAVE, PORTABLE PHONE OR LISTEN TO THE RADIO.

A young doctor in CA, Elizabeth Ploud, who was also a Clinical Laboratory Scientist, Medical Researcher,

Health Coach, Author, and International lecturer had MAJOR problems from a neighbor's smart meter. On the 4th day after installation, an itchy rash developed around her ankle, and spread quickly. In two weeks, it was solid over her legs, arms, stomach and back. Within minutes of using the computer or cell phone, she had bloody sores. She ruined clothing and bedding. After some time, she discovered it was the smart meter causing her problems. She has a beach near her, and she consistently grounded at the beach and got relief.

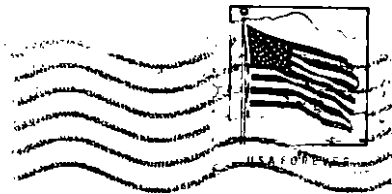
