Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph No. 2 of the Commission's Opinion and Order entered on March 21, 2017 ("March 21 Order") in the above-referenced proceeding, this matter was assigned to the Office of Administrative Law Judge for mediation.

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph No. 3 of that same Order, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement ("I&E") and Pine Roe Natural Gas Co., Inc. ("Pine Roe") had sixty (60) days for mediation to reach an agreement, with the option to request an additional thirty (30) days for mediation. By letter dated May 19, 2017, I&E filed an unopposed request for an extension of thirty (30) days for mediation. The ninety (90) day mediation period is scheduled to expire today, on July 5, 2017.

While Pine Roe has made progress in addressing the compliance issues raised by I&E in its Amended Complaint filed on March 4, 2016, the parties have not reached an agreement at this time that would fully address and resolve all issues encompassed in this proceeding. Accordingly, I&E requests that this case be assigned to an Administrative Law Judge for appropriate proceedings.
