Dear Secretary Chiavetta,

On July 6, 2017, a Secretarial Letter was issued in the above captioned proceeding, which allowed parties to comment on the proposed parameters of PECO's De Facto Heating Program set forth in Addendum F to its previously approved 2016-2018 Universal Service and Energy Conservation Plan.

On behalf of the Coalition for Affordable Utility Services and Energy Efficiency in Pennsylvania (CAUSE-PA), we respectfully request that the period for comment be extended for a period of 10 days, to July 31, 2017. Attorneys for CAUSE-PA have numerous immovable conflicts during the 20-day comment period, and its ability to fully review and provide comment on PECO's Plan would be significantly curtailed without this brief extension of time to file. Counsel for PECO, the Office of Consumer Advocate, and TURN et al. have each indicated to counsel for CAUSE-PA that they do not object to this request for brief extension.
