Motion for Continuance of Hearing

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), Kathie Johns (hereinafter “Complainant”), through counsel Community Legal Services, Inc., hereby moves a continuance of the hearing in this matter scheduled for July 21, 2017, and in support states as follows:

1. On or about May 19, 2017, Complainant filed a Formal Complaint against PECO Energy Company (hereinafter “Respondent”).
2. Complainant alleges a possible issue of foreign wiring affecting her PECO bill and desires that Respondent conduct a proper and complete investigation into possible foreign load.
3. Respondent states that it has done some investigation and suggests it is willing to do further investigation if given access by third parties--i.e. complainant’s landlord.
4. Accordingly this Complaint involves factually intensive inquiry into the adequacy of Respondent’s foreign load investigation, potential continuing existence of foreign wiring, and the steps Respondent claims third-parties must take in order for it to conduct a complete investigation.

5. Complainant's counsel requires additional time to conduct discovery if necessary, to attempt to negotiate a settlement, and to prepare properly for a hearing, should a hearing be necessary.

6. On July 12, 2017, Respondent's counsel stated to Complainant's counsel that Respondent agrees with this motion for change of the scheduled hearing date.

WHEREFORE, Complainant moves that the July 21, 2017 hearing be continued for at least 30 days.
