I am requesting that my suspension be lifted and the \$500. fine be waived because my insurance never lapsed and has been up to date with progressive ins. I was away on vacation from 6-10-17 to 6-24-17. I received my mail 6-26-17 with the notice of suspension. I contacted my agent Jonathan Palmos, of Truckers Insurance, and told him the puc did not receive the proper forms and he said he would take care of it. Then a few days later I received the complaint that was issuing the \$500 fine. Then a few days after that I received the notice to lift suspension of PUC operating authority dated June 30, 2017. I was contacted by Kathy Moyer of the PUC on July 5, 2017 and told that the notice to lift the suspension of PUC Operating authority was issued by mistake and the PUC still needed the form E filed and that I also would have to reply to this complaint or pay the fine. During this whole process I was in contact with my insurance agent Jonathan Palmos who had been in contact with Robert Bingaman, Motor carrier compliance office, who said the problem was with the form H filing but that problem had been resolved and everything was good. I am not sure where the problem lies at this time but I am asking that my fine be waived and my operating authority be reinstated because my insurance never lapsed.
