To Whom It May Concern:

On March 8, 2013, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement instituted a Complaint against EMS Southwest, Inc., Respondent, alleging failure to maintain evidence of bodily injury and property damage liability insurance on file with this Commission, a violation of the Public Utility Code at 66 Pa C.S. §512, 52 Pa. Code §32.2(c), and 52 Pa. Code §32.11(a), §32.12(a) or §32.13(a).

In accordance with 52 Pa. Code §5.61, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement notified the Respondent that, unless its insurer files evidence of insurance with this Commission and Respondent pays the proposed fine, Respondent must file an Answer to the Complaint within twenty (20) days of the date of service. The Notice further specified that, if Respondent failed to answer the Complaint within twenty (20) days, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement would request the Commission issue an Order that imposes a penalty, which could include a fine, cancellation, or any other remedy.

The Complaint was served on the Respondent on March 11, 2013. To date, more than twenty (20) days later, Respondent has failed to file an Answer to the Complaint. On March 18, 2013, the Respondent's insurer filed evidence of insurance effective on November 15, 2012; however, Respondent has failed to pay the fine.

Therefore, the allegations in the Complaint are admitted and the Complaint is sustained.

Respondent shall pay a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for failure to maintain evidence of insurance on file with this commission, 52 Pa. Code §32 within twenty (20) days from the date of this letter. Payment must be by certified check or money order, payable to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and mailed to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265, as provided in the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§3301 and 3315.

Respondent is hereby notified to cease and desist from further violations of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§101, et seq. and the regulations of the Commission, 52 Pa. Code §§1.1, et seq.
