Dear Secretary Chiavetta,

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's (Commission) Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) files this Petition for Leave to Withdraw the Complaint in the above-captioned case pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.94.

On August 31, 2016, I&E filed a Complaint alleging that Mariah Limousine Inc. (Respondent) failed to maintain evidence of liability insurance on file with the Commission in violation of the Public Utility Code at 66 Pa.C.S. § 512 and the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §§ 32.2(c) and 32.11(a). I&E's Complaint requested that Respondent pay a \$500 civil penalty and cause its insurer to file evidence of insurance with the Commission within twenty (20) days or be subject to cancellation of its Certificate of Public Convenience (Certificate).

On September 20, 2016, Respondent filed a letter-answer to I&E's Complaint asserting that it sold its only vehicle and therefore, no longer needed insurance. Further investigation revealed that Respondent had sold the vehicle to Crystal Limousine on July 1, 2016, which predates the lapse of Respondent's insurance and the initiation of the instant Complaint. Additionally, Respondent's Certificate at A-00120361 was cancelled on August 1, 2017 at Docket No. A-2017-2616490.

Given that Respondent sold the vehicle in question prior to the lapse of insurance and the initiation of the instant Complaint and because Respondent's Certificate has been cancelled, I&E is withdrawing the Complaint in the above-captioned matter.

If no party objects within 20 days of service of this letter, this case should be marked closed.


