The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's (Commission) Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) files this Petition for Leave to Withdraw the Complaint in the above-captioned case pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.94.

On June 2, 2016, I&E filed a Complaint alleging that Harold Leroy Shipman t/a Shipman Van Service (Respondent) violated Section 510(b) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. §510(b), for failing to file an assessment report demonstrating his gross intrastate operating revenues for the 2014 calendar year. The Complaint requested that Respondent pay a \$1,000 civil penalty within twenty days or be subject to cancellation of his Certificate of Public Convenience (Certificate). On June 16, 2016, Respondent filed an Application to abandon or discontinue his paratransit authority at A-00123110. The Commission's filing system indicates that this request was processed on August 31, 2017.

Given that Respondent's Certificate has been cancelled, I&E is withdrawing the Complaint in the above-captioned matter.

If no party objects to the withdrawal of the Complaint within 20 days of service of this letter, this case will be marked closed.
