Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Please accept this Letter Petition on behalf of Energy Plus Holdings LLC ("EPH") to renew its required level of financial security at the reduced level of 5%.

This renewal request is made consistent with the directives of the Commission's Bond Reduction Order,<sup>1</sup> and is being submitted at least 90 days prior to expiration date of EPH's current security. EPH has been a licensed EGS in the Commonwealth for more than two years. See Docket No. A-2009-2139745. EPH's current required level of financial security was initially approved by the Commission through its Secretarial Letter dated December 15, 2015. The reduction to 5% was continued by the Commission through the Secretarial Letter dated September 29, 2016 at the above referenced docket number.

Please find the following information in support:

- 1) EPH's gross receipts in Pennsylvania for the four most-recent quarters attached hereto as Appendix A (**CONFIDENTIAL**);
- 2) EPH is current with its tax liabilities to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and is providing (a) proof of its prepaid gross receipts taxes toward its estimated revenues for the current year and (b) a Tax Status Letter from the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue, which are both attached hereto as Appendix B (**CONFIDENTIAL**); and
- 3) EPH's Alternative Energy Portfolio Standards compliance data is attached hereto as Appendix C (**CONFIDENTIAL**).




