On Wednesday, September 6, 2017, we received via the mail your 14 individual interrogatory Discovery request and have been given only 13 days to answer.

Date of letter/date of service is August 31, 2017. Due to holiday, we received request September 6, 2017. Letter states "you must respond to each discovery request within twenty days after the date of service". That gives us only 13 days to respond.

We are kindly requesting an extension of time for Discovery and a new date for our Hearing (December 12, 2017), since Gerard will be released from a nursing home before the question answers are due, and I can't take care of him and do all the legal work involved in a pro se case; therefore, we are kindly asking for a "humanitarian" extension of Discovery and Hearing date either until my husband gets well or passes over.

We are currently waiting on ALL of his past and current medical records referred to by Dr. Gisler in his letter from Gerard's care physician. These records are kept in Cont. Med. In Texas.

In conclusion, we would very much appreciate being granted extensions.

I am writing this letter on behalf of Gerald Kurzawski at the request of his wife. Mr. Kurzawski has end stage renal disease (ESRD) and is on dialysis at the Fresenius South Hills Clinic in Pittsburgh, PA. The etiology of his ESRD is presumed to be secondary to diabetes. He also has a history of hypertension and hepatitis C, which may have contributed to his kidney disease. The patient was initiated on dialysis in September 2016. The patient has additional comorbid conditions to include nephrolithiasis (kidney stones), TIAs, hypothyroidism, and hyperlipidemia. He also has a history of depression.
