

PREHEARING ORDER

The undersigned has been designated as the presiding officer in this matter. A telephonic hearing in this case is now scheduled for August 24, 2017, at 1:30 p.m. I will initiate the hearing by calling the parties at the telephone numbers included on the Notice at 1:30 p.m. on that date:

You must be available when I call you, or you may lose this case. If you will be at a telephone number that is different than the number on the hearing notice, you must notify me of that telephone number before the hearing. In addition, the parties shall comply with the following requirements:

1. Commission policy promotes settlements. 52 Pa. Code §5.231(a). The utility is directed to contact the complainant at least seven (7) days before the scheduled hearing to discuss possible settlement of this case. Even if the parties are unable to settle this case, they may still resolve some of the questions or issues during their discussions. If the parties reach an agreement on all issues, a formal hearing will not be necessary and the scheduled hearing will be cancelled.

2. A request for a change of the scheduled hearing date must state the agreement or opposition of other parties, and must be submitted no later than two (2) days prior to the hearing.
