## PREHEARING CONFERENCE MEMORANDUM OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPOTATION

In accordance with the August 8, 2017, Prehearing Conference Order issued by Administrative Law Judge David A. Salapa, in the above referenced matter, the Department of Transportation ("Department") offers the following in response to the specific requests contained therein:

1. It is requested that the Department's sole entry on the service list shall be as follows:

- The Department is of the current opinion that this matter cannot be settled. The Department is not opposed to continued discussions.
- 3. Discovery, if any, should be completed forty-five (45) days prior to the hearing.
- 4. The Department proposes a March hearing with written direct testimony due twenty (20) days and rebuttal due ten (10) days prior to the hearing. Main briefs can be due thirty (30) days after receipt of transcript and reply briefs twenty (20) days later.
- 5. The Department intends to call the following as witnesses and reserves the right to call additional or other witnesses as the case develops:

Ms. Hazelton will offer testimony regarding the Department's position that Norfolk Southern is responsible for the ongoing maintenance and future replacement of the subject structures.

Mr. Babinski will offer testimony regarding the condition of the bridges, outstanding maintenance needs and time frames for completion of the work, the anticipated lifespans of the bridges and the costs associated with maintenance and future replacement.

Ms. Fenton will offer testimony regarding the location of each of the bridges, average daily traffic and other general site information.

- 6. It is the Department's position that Norfolk Southern is responsible for the performing and paying for the ongoing maintenance and future replacement of the bridges that are the subject of these proceedings. The Department intends to offer inspection reports that are subject to the ongoing Protective Order, maps, cost estimates and any other documentation deemed relevant during the preparation for this hearing.
- 7. There is an outstanding request that these matters be consolidated.
