MOTION OF COMMISSIONER DAVID W. SWEET

The matter before us is the Initial Decision (ID) of Administrative Law Judge Angela T. Jones (ALJ) which upholds Philadelphia Gas Works' (PGW's) claim of meter tampering but reduces the time period for which the landlord is held to be responsible. As the time period is reduced, then the amount due for unbilled use also needs to be adjusted.

In her ordering paragraphs, the ALJ directed PGW to have the Commission's Bureau of Technical Utility Services verify the correctness of its recalculation before billing Mr. Ren.


Consistent with Commission practice, a better course of action is to direct PGW to calculate and bill the correct amount to the Complainant in this proceeding. Also, the Company is directed to use the stated amount as the payment due before PGW will restore service to the residence.

THEREFORE,

I MOVE:

1. That the Commission's final order direct Philadelphia Gas Works to calculate the correct amount that it may require Guan Hui Ren pay as a prerequisite to restoration of gas service to the subject residence.
2. That the Office of Special Assistants prepare an order consistent with this Motion.
