

If agents violate any of Median's guidelines for marketing, which incorporate the Commission's requirements, agents are terminated.

All of Median's sales are confirmed by third party verification process performed by a leading independent provider of TPV services. All recordings and TPV will follow the requirements codified the Commission's regulations and will be designed to confirm the customer's intent to enroll supply service with Median.

Median employs a customer service team to respond to customer concerns and complaints. Upon receiving a contact from a customer, the customer service team investigates the concern and provides the customer with a timely response. If the investigation identifies a potential issue or deviation from Median's requirements for sales and marketing, the matter is escalated and the appropriate action is taken with the sales vendor and/or agent in question.

 - Applicant will be required to meet periodic reporting requirements as may be issued by the Commission to fulfill the Commission's duty under Chapter 28 pertaining to reliability and to inform the Governor and Legislature of the progress of the transition to a fully competitive electric market.



MEDIAN ENERGY is licensed by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to offer electricity generation and natural gas services in Pennsylvania. Our PUC license number for electricity generation supply is ______.

Your electricity generation prices and charges will be set by MEDIAN ENERGY. The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission regulates electricity transmission prices and services. Natural gas commodity prices and charges are set by MEDIAN. The Public Utility Commission regulates electricity and natural gas distribution prices and services.

You will continue to receive your bill from your Electric Distribution Company (EDC) which includes both the EDC's distribution charges and MEDIAN ENERGY's charges for electricity supply. You will receive a single bill from your Natural Gas Distribution Company ("NGDC") which will includes both the NGDC's distribution charges and MEDIAN ENERGY's charges for natural gas supply. Your EDC and NGDC will continue to provide all emergency repairs and services. MEDIAN ENERGY is not affiliated with and does not represent your EDC or NGDC.

Right of Rescission - You may cancel this Agreement at any time before midnight of the third business day after receiving this disclosure statement by contacting MEDIAN ENERGY by phone at 1-888-316-5443 or by mail at the address above.

Definitions: <u>Generation Charge</u> - Charge for production of electricity. <u>Transmission Charge</u> - Charge for moving high voltage electricity from a generation facility to the distribution lines of an electric distribution company. <u>Commodity Charges</u>- The charges for basic gas supply service which is sold either by volume (Ccf or Mcf) or heating value (Dekatherms).

1. Agreement to Sell and Purchase Electricity and Natural

Gas. MEDIAN ENERGY PA, LLC ("MEDIAN ENERGY," "Seller," "we," or "us") and the undersigned customer ("Customer," "you," or "your") under which Customer shall initiate electricity and natural gas supply service and begin enrollment with MEDIAN ENERGY (the "Agreement"). Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, MEDIAN ENERGY agrees to sell and facilitate delivery of the quantity of electricity necessary to meet Customer's requirements based upon consumption data obtained by MEDIAN ENERGY from the EDC, and the quantity of natural gas necessary to meet Customer's requirements based upon consumption data obtained by MEDIAN ENERGY from the NGDC.

2. Customer Acknowledgements – Customer acknowledges the following: That any sales representative with whom Customer has spoken represents MEDIAN ENERGY, and is not from the EDC or NGDS; and that you are the Customer whose name is on the account, the spouse of the account holder, or over 18 and authorized to make decisions about the account.

3. Term - This Agreement shall commence as of the date enrollment with MEDIAN ENERGY is deemed effective by the EDC and/or NGDC. This Agreement shall continue for 12 (twelve) billing cycles (the Initial Term). Unless otherwise agreed to, upon completion of an Initial Term, this Agreement will renew on a month-to- month basis with a monthly variable "Renewal Term"). You will receive two separate written notifications that precede the expiration date. These notifications will explain your options going forward. Customer may terminate this agreement at any time with no fee or penalty. <u>There is no fee for cancelling this Agreement</u>.

4. Price - This is a variable price agreement. The price you are charged for electricity supply will reflect the cost of electricity obtained from the PJM Interconnection (including energy, capacity, settlement, ancillaries), related transmission and distribution charges and other market-related factors, plus all applicable taxes, fees, charges or other assessments and Seller's costs, expenses and margins. Your Median Energy price includes Transmission Charges and estimated Total State Taxes, including the Gross Receipts Tax, but excludes applicable state and local Sales Tax. There is no limit on the amount that your price can decrease or increase from month to month. Your MEDIAN ENERGY electricity price may be higher or lower than the EDC's price in any particular month, and there is no maximum price. The price you are charged for natural gas supply will be a variable price that can change from month to month. The price is based on the wholesale cost of natural gas from the NYMEX exchange (including commodity, capacity, storage and balancing), transportation to the Delivery Point, and other market-related factors, plus all applicable taxes, fees,

margins. Your price includes estimated total state taxes, but excludes Pennsylvania sales tax, if applicable. Our price does not include Distribution Utility service and other Utility-related charges, which are separate amounts that you must pay to the NGDC. There is no limit on the amount that your price can decrease or increase from month to month. Your MEDIAN ENERGY natural gas price may be higher or lower than the NGDC's price in any particular month, and there is no maximum price. Customers can call MEDIAN ENERGY at 1-888-316-5443 or visit our website at www.Medianenergy.com for current variable pricing and the previous 24 months' average billed historical prices (or as many months of data as is available to date, up to 24 months). *Please note that historical prices are not indicative of present or future pricing*.

5. Starting Price – The starting price for electricity generation supply for customers starting on or about {month} is { } per kWh. This price will apply to your first month of service from MEDIAN ENERGY. The starting price for natural gas supply for customers starting on or about {month} is { } per therm. This price will apply to your first month of service from MEDIAN ENERGY.

6. Billing and Payment - Customer will receive a single bill from the EDC which will includes both the EDC's distribution charges and MEDIAN ENERGY's charges for electricity supply. Customer will receive a single bill from the NGDC which will includes both the NGDC's distribution charges and MEDIAN ENERGY's charges for natural gas supply.

7. Delivery Point, Title, and Taxes – All electricity sold pursuant to this Agreement shall be delivered to a location ("Point of Delivery"), which shall constitute the point at which the sale occurs and title to the energy passes to you from us. All natural gas sold pursuant to this Agreement shall be delivered to a location ("Point of Delivery"), which shall constitute the point at which the sale occurs and title to the energy passes to you from us. Customer will be liable for and pay all taxes or surcharges which are imposed with respect to the sale of electricity and natural gas. If Customer is exempt from such taxes, Customer is responsible for identifying and requesting any exemption from the collection of the taxes by filing appropriate documentation with MEDIAN ENERGY. Cancellation - Customer may terminate this agreement at any time by contacting the MEDIAN ENERGY Customer Service Department at 1-888-316-5443 between 8:30 a.m. - 6 p.m. ET Monday-Friday(Hours subject to change); by writing to us at: MEDIAN ENERGY, 1 Lethbridge Plaza, Suite 4/4A, Mahwah, NJ 07430; or by e-mail us at all@Medianenergy.com. MEDIAN ENERGY may cancel this agreement at any time upon providing written notice to Customer. Common reasons for MEDIAN ENERGY to cancel this agreement would include: Non-Payment – If your electricity or natural gas service is terminated by your EDC or NGDC, then this agreement is cancelled on the date that your service is terminated. You will owe us for amounts unpaid for our charges for electricity or natural gas supply up to the date of termination. Customer Move – If the customer moves from the address listed above, this agreement is cancelled. If we cancel this agreement for

any reason other than for customer non-naumont we will

follow applicable rules in providing notice to you.

9. Entire Agreement - This Agreement, including the Contract Summary, makes up the entire Agreement between Customer and MEDIAN ENERGY. MEDIAN ENERGY makes no representations other than those expressly set forth in this Agreement. MEDIAN ENERGY provides and Customer receives no warranties, express or implied, statutory, or otherwise and MEDIAN ENERGY specifically disclaims any warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose.

10. Force Majeure - In the event that either party is rendered unable, wholly or in part, to perform that party's obligations under this Agreement due to events not reasonably anticipated or within either party's control, such as, but not limited to, acts of God, curtailment by Customer's EDC or NGDC, etc., the Parties agree that such nonperformance shall be excused for the duration of the event which caused it. Should the parties have cause to daim force majeure, the claiming party will notify the other party, in writing, of the cause(s) of such event, the anticipated duration of non-performance and the remedies being taken to eliminate the cause. Financial obligations relating to payment for or delivery of electricity or natural gas under this Agreement cannot be cause for claiming force majeure and obligations cannot be excused as a result of a force majeure event.

11. Liability - Our liability shall be limited to direct actual damages only, which will not exceed the amount of your single largest monthly invoice during the preceding 12 months. All other remedies at law or in equity are hereby waived. In no event shall we be liable for any punitive, incidental, consequential, exemplary, indirect, third-party claims, lost profits or other damages whether based on contract, warranty, tort, negligence, strict liability or otherwise any cause of action or claim for any liability, arising from a breach of this Agreement.

12. Dispute Resolution - In the event of a billing dispute or a disagreement involving MEDIAN ENERGY's service hereunder, the parties will use their best efforts to resolve the dispute. Customer should contact MEDIAN ENERGY by telephone or in writing as provided below. If you are not satisfied after discussing your concerns with us you may contact the Public Utility Commission (PUC) by phone at: 1-800-692-7380 or in writing at PO Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265.

13. Assignment - You may not assign this Agreement, in whole or in part, or any of your rights or obligations without MEDIAN ENERGY's prior written consent. We may, upon thirty days prior notice and without your consent: (a) transfer, sell, pledge, encumber or assign this Agreement or the accounts, revenues or proceeds in connection with any financial or billing services agreement; or (b) transfer or assign this Agreement any other approved supplier authorized by the PUC. This Agreement shall be binding on each party's successors and legal assigns.

14. Governing Law - This Agreement is governed by the laws of the state of Pennsylvania. This Agreement is subject to present and future legislation, orders, rules, regulations or decisions of a duly constituted governmental authority having jurisdiction over

some future date there is a change in any law, rule, regulation or tariff whereby MEDIAN ENERGY is prevented, prohibited or frustrated from carrying out the terms of the Agreement, at its sole discretion MEDIAN ENERGY shall have the right to cancel this Agreement.

15. WAIVER OF JURY TRIAL. ALL CLAIMS AND DISPUTES ARISING UNDER OR RELATING TO THIS AGREEMENT ARE TO BE SETTLED BY BINDING ARBITRATION IN THE STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA OR ANOTHER LOCATION MUTUALLY AGREEABLE TO THE PARTIES. THE ARBITRATION SHALL BE CONDUCTED ON A CONFIDENTIAL BASIS PURSUANT TO THE COMMERCIAL ARBITRATION RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. ANY DECISION OR AWARD AS A RESULT OF ANY SUCH ARBITRATION PROCEEDING SHALL BE IN WRITING AND SHALL PROVIDE AN EXPLANATION FOR ALL CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND FACT AND SHALL INCLUDE THE ASSESSMENT OF COSTS, EXPENSES, AND REASONABLE ATTORNEYS' FEES. ANY SUCH ARBITRATION SHALL BE CONDUCTED BY AN ARBITRATOR EXPERIENCED IN COMPETITIVE RETAIL ENERGY MARKET AND SHALL INCLUDE A WRITTEN RECORD OF THE ARBITRATION HEARING. THE PARTIES RESERVE THE RIGHT TO OBJECT TO ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO SHALL BE EMPLOYED BY OR AFFILIATED WITH A COMPETING ORGANIZATION OR ENTITY. AN AWARD OF ARBITRATION MAY BE CONFIRMED IN A COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION. CUSTOMER WILL NOT HAVE THE RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE IN A REPRESENTATIVE CAPACITY OR AS A MEMBER OF ANY CLASS OF CLAIMANTS PERTAINING TO ANY CLAIM SUBJECT TO ARBITRATION.

16. Information Release Authorization - Customer

authorizes MEDIAN ENERGY to obtain and review the following information from the EDC and NGDC: consumption history; billing determinants; and account number. This information may be used by MEDIAN ENERGY to determine whether it will commence and/or continue to provide energy supply service to Customer. The information referenced in this paragraph will not be disclosed to a third party unless required by law. Customer's execution of this Agreement shall constitute authorization for the release of this information to MEDIAN ENERGY. This authorization will remain in effect during the Initial Term and any Renewal Term. Customer may rescind this authorization at any time by providing written notice thereof to MEDIAN ENERGY or by calling MEDIAN ENERGY. MEDIAN ENERGY reserves the right to cancel this Agreement in the event Customer rescinds the authorization.

Contact Information

17. Measurement - Both parties agree hereto to accept for purposes of accounting for quantity, quality and measurement of electricity as supplied and reported by the EDC. Both parties agree hereto to accept for purposes of accounting for quantity, quality and measurement of natural gas as supplied and reported by the NGDC.

18. Severability - If any provision of this Agreement is held by a court or regulatory agency of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force without being invalidated in any way.

19. Delay or Failure to Exercise Rights - No partial performance, delay or failure on our part in exercising any rights under this Agreement and no partial or single exercise thereof shall constitute a waiver of such rights or of any other rights hereunder.

20. Taxes and Laws - Except as otherwise provided in this Agreement or by law, all taxes due and payable with respect to your performance of your obligations under this Agreement, shall be paid by the Customer. Any lawful tax exemption will only be recognized on a prospective basis from the date that you provide valid tax-exemption certificates to us.

21. Emergency Services - The EDC and NGDC will continue to respond to leaks and emergencies. In the event of an electricity and/or natural gas emergency or service interruption, contact your EDC or NGDC at one of the telephone numbers listed below.

22. Notices - If you have a fixed term agreement with us that is longer than 3 months and it is approaching the expiration date or whenever we propose to change the terms of service in any type of contract, you will receive two separate written notifications that precede either the expiration date or the effective date of the proposed changes. These notifications will explain your options going forward. At least 60-75 days prior to the expiration date or proposed change, we will send you the first written notice. A second notice with options for your consideration will be sent to you no later than forty-five (45) days prior to the expiration date or proposed change to your terms of service.


