Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Laurel Pipe Line Company, L.P. ("Laurel") submits this correspondence in response to the Secretarial Letter dated October 26, 2017 ("Secretarial Letter"). The Secretarial Letter requested the Parties to submit correspondence by November 2, 2017, regarding the status of two-conditions contained in a June 8, 2017 letter filed by Gulf Operating, LLC, Philadelphia Energy Solutions and Marketing, LLC, Sheetz, Inc., Monroe Energy, Inc., and Giant Eagle, Inc. (the "Joint Petitioners"), related to the April 20, 2017 Petition for Interlocutory Review and Answer to a Material Question filed by the Joint Petitioners ("Petition").

The first condition requested an extension or modification of the existing litigation schedule, consistent with that request in the Joint Petitioners' June 1, 2017 Motion for Modification and Extension of the Procedural Schedule. As noted in the Letter, on June 14, 2017, the ALJ conducted a prehearing conference during which the parties discussed the issues raised in the Motion for Modification. The Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") extended the litigation schedule by approximately one month by Order dated June 20, 2017. Therefore, Laurel believes this condition has been satisfied.

The second condition requested a written agreement by all Parties, subject to acceptance by the ALJ in an appropriate order, that no Party will move to strike any testimony regarding "any plans or discussions about flow reversals on Laurel's pipeline east of Eldorado, Pennsylvania." Laurel


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initiated correspondence with the Parties regarding the second condition by e-mail on October 31, 2017, and indicated that, per its prior June 6, 2017 letter, it would not move to strike testimony regarding this information on the basis of relevance, but reserved its rights to argue in its testimony, briefs and exceptions and/or reply exceptions that the information is not relevant.

As a result of subsequent e-mail correspondence with the Parties, Laurel represents that all Parties have agreed not to move to strike testimony regarding "any plans or discussions about flow reversals on Laurel's pipeline east of Eldorado, Pennsylvania," and have reserved their rights to argue the relevance of this information in testimony, briefs and exceptions and/or reply exceptions.

Therefore, Laurel respectfully represents that the two conditions in the Joint Petitioners June 8 Letter have been fulfilled, and, as such, the pending Petition is now moot.

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
