

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

On September 7, 2017, Keystone Moving & Junk Removal, LLC (“Keystone”) filed the above-referenced Application with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) to “to transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, household goods in use, between points within a 100 mile radius of Cumberland, Perry, Dauphin, Lancaster, and York counties in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.” The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission issued a Secretarial Compliance Letter in relation to this application on November 1, 2017. Keystone would like to amend its Application to request authority: “to transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, household goods in use, *between points in Pennsylvania.*” Therefore Keystone respectfully requests that the Commission issue a revised Secretarial Compliance Letter, clarifying that Keystone has authority to transport as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, household goods between points in Pennsylvania.
