

the customer's household income; 2) catastrophic damage to the customer's residence resulting in a significant net cost; 3) loss of the customer's residence; and 4) increase in the customer's number of dependents in the household. 66 Pa.C.S. § 1403.

11. The Complainant has not met her burden of demonstrating that she experienced a significant change in circumstances as defined by 66 Pa.C.S. § 1403.

ORDER

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Complaint of Kimberley Chambers against Philadelphia Gas Works at Docket No. C-2016-2538724 is denied and dismissed;
2. That the record at Docket No. C-2016-2538724 be marked closed.
