We received a Notice of Hearing in this matter dated November 16, 2017 scheduling an initial call-in telephonic hearing on January 8, 2018. The purpose of this letter is to alert you that in addition to the timely Answer filed by Raiser-PA d/b/a Uber (“Uber” or the “Company”) on October 10, 2017, the Company also filed Preliminary Objections.

The Company believes resolution of the Preliminary Objections will dispose of some or all of the Complaint, narrowing the number of issues to be tried at hearing. Therefore, the Company respectfully requests the initial hearing scheduled January 8, 2018 be rescheduled to a point 45 days after the Preliminary Objections are resolved.
