

In response to your denial from the Gas Company to the PUC exception:

1. Why are you disregarding the fact that Schina Behlin did not sign the lease agreement?
2. Why did you refuse to give me back responsibility when I asked in December 2015? As a result, you gave Schina responsibility of a commercial property with one gas meter. Since she did not sign the rental agreement that made her responsible for the whole building. In addition, she evicted her partners, AOK Business service and Nichole Fedder from the premises, therefore, using the store front as her daycare center and the business office as her living room.
3. The gas Company lied to me because they told me I could not take responsibility until she moved from the property. Then why did the gas company change my responsibility in August, 2016 since she did not move out until evicted in September 2016? The judicial system on this kind of situation is despicable.

This conspiracy between Schina Behlin and the gas company is unconscionable. Why should you charge me for a gas bill over which I had no control? Schina was the only occupant in the premises from October 2015 until September 2016. No matter what the lease said, no one signed it and no one abided by its agreement and no one paid any rent including Schina Behlin. Without her signature, the Gas Company should not have given her responsibility of the gas in that building. Since all that was done without my permission, the responsibility belongs to the Gas Company and Schina Behlin
