Dear Ms. Chiavetta:

Two recent communications from Joel H. Cheskis, Deputy Chief Administrative Law Judge, cite, among other statements, the Commission's intention to initiate a precipitous, belated, and inappropriate "telephonic hearing" in the above case. Those recent communications ignore the current status of that case. The issues in that case are now subsumed under appeal before the Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania, and a Petition for Review has been identified with Docket Number 1636 CD 2017. Any attempt by the PUC to impose its authority over that of the Commonwealth Court is inappropriate.

By presuming to conduct a “telephonic hearing” on December 11, 2017, the PUC is acting without authority and attempts to enforce an ill-timed and inappropriate initiative. Mr. Cheskis’ a priori exclusion of relevant evidence only further demonstrate the inappropriate action of the PUC. Furthermore, the fact that I received only two-weeks’ notice is nothing short of inconsiderate.

Unless and until the Commonwealth Court directs otherwise, I will continue to regard the proposed “telephonic hearing” as illegitimate and will not assume any obligation to participate in it.
