Re: *PSEG Energy Solutions LLC Request to Amend Electric Generation Supplier License – Docket No. A-2016-2576325*

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

PSEG Energy Solutions LLC (PSEG ES) respectfully requests the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) amend its Electric Generation Supplier (“EGS”) license to enable it to serve the additional classes of residential and small commercial (25 kw and under demand) customers in mixed meter scenarios consistent with the Commission’s March 25, 2011 Secretarial Letter entered at Docket No. M-2009-2082042 (“Mixed Meter Letter”).

Currently, PSEG ES is licensed to offer, render, furnish or supply electricity or electric generation services to large commercial (over 25 kw demand), industrial and governmental customers in all of the electric distribution company service territories throughout the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. PSEG ES is not licensed to serve residential and small commercial customers, but seeks to serve these customers only if such service is part of, or incidental to, a large commercial or industrial contract in a mixed meter scenario. As such, PSEG ES seeks to amend its license to include the authority to serve residential and small commercial customers in a mixed meter scenario.

PSEG ES has no intention at this time to separately market to any residential or small commercial customers and therefore, pursuant to the Mixed Meter Letter, has not submitted a disclosure statement with this request. If PSEG ES decides to market directly to residential or small customers in the future, it will submit a disclosure statement at that time, as required by 52 Pa. Code § 54.5.

PSEG ES provided a \$250,000 surety bond with its original application. In addition, since PSEG ES only seeks to change the type of customers who are served under its license, it has not published notice of this request in newspapers of general circulation.
