Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

On April 12, 2017, Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light”) filed an Application requesting all approvals necessary under the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code to convert from a business corporation to a limited liability company (“LLC”), pursuant to the Pennsylvania Entity Transactions Law (“ETL”), 15 Pa. C.S. §§ 311, *et seq.*

By Order entered August 31, 2017, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“PUC” or “Commission”) approved Duquesne Light’s Application, but indicated, in ordering paragraph number 2, “That the Applicant will file a notice upon completion of the conversion to a limited liability company. If the Applicant determines that the conversion will not take place, then they shall promptly so notify this Commission.” Consistent with that direction, this letter serves as notification that the conversions have taken place.

Specifically, the four entities converted as part of the internal restructuring plan and the dates of the conversions are as follows:
