RE: Formal complaint filed against Metropolitan Edison Company


As a courtesy, we are replying to the Answer and New Matter that was filed by the Metropolitan Edison Company through it's counsel in response to the formal complaint that we previously filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission regarding threat of electric shut-off due to lack of consent to the installation of a radiation emitting "Smart Meter" by Metropolitan Edison Company on our property located at 50 Frystown Road, Myerstown, Pennsylvania.

We find the Answer and New Matter that has been set forth by Metropolitan Edison Company to be completely lacking of any substance which addresses our basic right to health, privacy and safety. There has been no long term health study that has been done to ascertain the effects of "Smart Meters" on human health, though there are studies to show pulsed microwave radiation to be harmful. The Metropolitan Edison Company has no authority to install something on our home or on our property which has the capacity to do us harm.

The Metropolitan Edison Company has not been denied access to read the analog meter which is installed on our property. Quite contrary to their erroneous statement, the last meter reading took place on November 27th, 2017. However, The Metropolitan Edison Company has no consent, implied or otherwise, that it may install a smart meter on our property.

In our formal complaint previously filed, we noted the desire to have our home be a place of refuge, not a place of refuse as was erroneously restated in the Answer and New Matter. We firmly state now that that is not merely a desire, but a basic, undeniable and unarguable right for our home to be our refuge.
