He spent a decade at the combined entities in various roles and markets. Kenneth has lived and worked in PJM since 2008 and relocated to the Commonwealth of PA just before the Electricity Rate Cap Expiration. He has lived in PA, met his wife and started his family all in PA, and it will continue to be the base of his business. The PA Electricity and Natural Gas brokerage licenses will be the first filed because of geography, but also a large existing customer base seeking procurement services. 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
