

PPL Electric's Response:

While constructing the Lauschtown – South Akron 69/138kV transmission line, PPL Electric damaged township roadways. As a result, the township requested PPL Electric reimburse it for the costs to repair the damaged roads. The township's request was amicably resolved and there was no litigation.

Reference Filing, Damage Release Agreement - Please show how the cost was determined.

PPL Electric's Response:

The cost was determined through negotiation between PPL Electric Right of Way and Project Management personnel and the Caernarvon Township Road Master and Office Manager. Caernarvon Township procured repair estimates from local contractors, following which discussions were held with PPL Electric to review the current age and condition of the area to be repaired. Once all terms were agreed to, the amount to be paid by PPL Electric was determined and agreed upon by both parties (\$25,000.00).


Please see Attachment 1. PPL Electric does not sign its own damage releases as the document does not obligate the Company to perform work or take action.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Caernarvon Township
2139 Main St. Narvon, PA 17555,

for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty- Five Thousand dollars 00/100
Dollars (\$ 25,000.00) in hand paid by PPL Electric Utilities Corporation, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged, do hereby remise, release, quitclaim and forever discharge the said PPL
Electric Utilities Corporation, its respective officers, agents, employees, successors, assigns and
all persons or entities, whether or not named herein, who may be jointly or severally liable, of and
from all suits, claims, demands, actions, damages and claims for damages or contribution
whatsoever arising out of or resulting from any injury, loss or damage that may have been caused
to Township roads crops, grain, land, and personal property in the Township of
Caernarvon, County of Lancaster, Commonwealth of
Pennsylvania, by reason of the construction, reconstruction and/or maintenance by the said PPL
Electric Utilities Corporation of its overhead and/or underground electric line facilities, upon, over,
under and across said property to the day of the date of these presents. Owner shall maintain in
the strictest confidence the terms of this Agreement, including the amount payable hereunder.

**"This Agreement is between a public utility and a municipal corporation and is therefore
subject to Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC") review pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S.A.
§ 507. The Effective Date of this Agreement shall be the later of i) thirty (30) days from the
date that PPL submits the Agreement to the PUC; or ii) if the PUC opens an investigation of
the Agreement, on the date the PUC approves the Agreement."**
