
On behalf of our client Marathon Power LLC ("Marathon"), enclosed please find a response to your January 17, 2018 letter, received on January 19, 2018.

Thank you for your attention to this application.



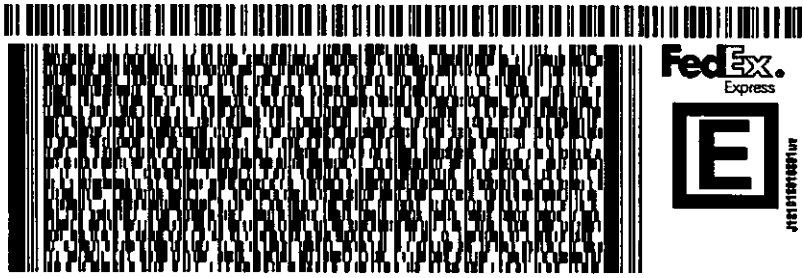

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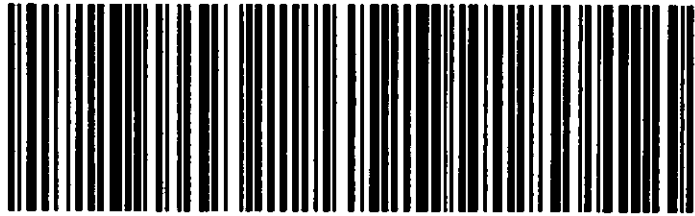
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
