I had called last year about the fine, and the man I talked to said he would take care of it and not to worry about it. I'm sorry I don't recall the person's name that I spoke with.



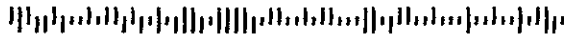
