Dear Mr. Ryan:

In my request for witnesses on January 23, 2018, I identified potential witnesses not only by name, but by specific and critical roles with regard to PPL's billing practices and their roles in implementing those practices for my PV renewable generating system.

Your reply offers a most uncertain answer. According to your letter of February 2, 2018, PPL "anticipates calling and presenting Cheryl Oehler and Tammy Nalesnic as witnesses at the hearing on March 6, 2018" but immediately "reserves the right to substitute these witnesses".

It is not clear from your letter whether PPL is agreeing to comply with the specific items in my request. Those five items are repeated here. Please respond to each item within three days and indicate the extent to which the Company intends to comply with each.

1. The PPL employee responsible for preparing the year-end "calculation sheets" requested by Larry Moyer in a letter dated April 25, 2017.
2. Ms. Cheryl Oehler or other person(s) who is now responsible for functions that were previously under the jurisdiction of Mr. Aloysius P. Cannon,

namely billing applications, policies, and processes for PPL Electric as well as the interface between net metering customers and PPL's billing system.

3. Ms. Cheryl Oehler or other person(s) who is now responsible for authorizing, supervising, and implementing the billing practices used for Larry Moyer's renewable system).
4. Ms. Tammy Nalesnic, who responded directly to Larry Moyer's calls.
5. Other customer service representative(s) responsible for helping to resolve the issue of missing credit on Larry Moyer's recent monthly statements.
