On January 4, 2018, my office served the Initial Decision of Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Darlene D. Heep in the above docketed case. My office received Exceptions from the Complainants to the Initial Decision (ID) of ALJ Heep on January 19, 2018. However, it was discovered that the ID was never properly served on the Respondent by the Secretary's Bureau.

Our further review revealed that the Complainants' Exceptions had no certificate of service or other indication that the Respondent had been served with the Complainants' Exceptions. Therefore, we have enclosed a copy of the ID and Complainant's Exceptions under cover of this Secretarial Letter to constitute service for purposes of 52 Pa. Code §5.533.

Therefore, due to the improper service of the ID, and the failure of the Complainants to provide service on all the parties of record to the case, and in order to avoid prejudice to any party pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.535, the Respondent shall have until Tuesday, February 20, 2018, to file Reply Exceptions.
