My father, Randall Stewart, is an affected
landowner. He resides at 28 Stewart Road in Airville.

3. The grounds for our protest of this proposal:

- Towers with open hangers exist, and run parallel to the
proposed route, within approximately 3 miles of the site.
- This project is of no benefit to PA residents. Construction
should be pursued in the vicinity of the area needing
supplemental power.
- Taking preserved farmland should not be an option for
"market efficiency" projects.

4. This directly affects me by

Reducing the value and appeal of preserved farm land
and hunting ground. It would also create a visual and
audible blemish less than 500 feet from the farm house.
This is not an acceptable clearance, and poses health risks
associated with exposure to electromagnetic fields.

This historic farm has been in our family for 200 years. The inheritance will be tragically impacted for my generation, and any in the future, if this project is allowed. Please protect York County's farmland - just as the owners thought they were doing when they placed the land under preservation.

WHEREFORE, Randall Stewart, Jr. respectfully requests Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to investigate and the filing, and strongly impose a condition that all other existing rights of way and infrastructure should be utilized before any new power line projects are approved, and **the Commission should deny the Transource filing.**
