

4. This directly affects me as the proposed Transource 230 kV project will destroy the value and use of our **residential property**. The 230 kV lines will also eliminate our ability to sell the property at a future date. The project will also ruin the scenic view that was a major selling point when we purchased this property.

According to the Transmission Lines Fact Sheet on the PUC PA.GOV website, "The proposed route must be established as the best out of other alternatives considering safety; environmental impacts; impacts on scenic and historic sights; existing land use; soil and sedimentation; plant and wildlife habitats; terrain; hydrology; and landscape. "



If the **existing underutilized** transmission line routes, which almost parallel the proposed Transource Route, were to be used for the proposed Transource Project, there **would not** be any disruption to the many existing property owners. By using an existing underutilized transmission line right of way, there would be **no** impact on safety; environmental impacts; impacts on scenic and historic sites; existing land use; soil and sedimentation; plant and wildlife habitats; terrain; hydrology; and landscape.

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

