- 2. My interest in this project is as a landowner, concerned father/grandfather, steward of the land and resident of York County.
- 3. Existing participants in the filing may not understand:
 - a. That Land will be devalued for this unnecessary project. What you can do with your land determines the value of it. Our local township zoning officers created laws to protect our lands from sub-division and other unnecessary development. Farm lands need to remain as agricultural.
 - b. That this project will bring environmental concerns from the stray shocks and electromagnetic fields coming from these proposed lines. As I travel under current power lines, there are times when the radio station has static and cell phones are unable to be used.
