I, DANIEL S. FRANKSTON, HEREBY DECLARE AS FOLLOWS:

1. I reside at 895 29<sup>th</sup> Avenue, #203, San Francisco, California, and knew Donna Bervinchak for almost twenty (20) years before she moved to Lancaster, as she was my partner, Eleanor Gomez's, good friend and school mate. I submit this Declaration in support of her request to not have a "smart meter" installed in her current Pennsylvania residence.

2. I have read the Declaration of Eleanor Gomez. Although I was not present for the entire time that Ms. Bervinchak stayed with Eleanor, I was there when she first arrived at the house, as well as virtually every evening that she stayed there.

3. When Ms. Bervinchak arrived at the house, she looked terribly ill and exhibited all of the symptoms described in Eleanor's Declaration. Upon her arrival at Eleanor's, I disconnected the router (which transmits the signal from the computer to the television) and turned off Eleanor's smart phone. Eleanor's house does not have a "smart meter."

4. After only a couple of hours at Eleanor's house, Donna began to look much better. Over the next few days, her condition continued to improve and she was beginning to look more like the Donna that I had known for many years.

5. I vividly recall that, one evening, we were eating dinner and Donna sat on the floor next to where I was sitting. After only a few minutes, Donna complained that she was feeling nauseous and felt a headache coming on. She asked me if I had a cell phone on me or any other devices that emitted electromagnetic fields. After initially telling her "no", I remembered that I had installed "The Clapper," an EMT emitting device that allows us to turn the living room lights on and off remotely. This device was located less than four feet from where Donna was sitting. I

disconnected "The Clapper" and her symptoms subsided a few moments later.

I declare under penalty of perjury of the laws of the State of California that the foregoing is true and

January 25, 2018 - SMART METER PROBLEMS:

I am writing to tell you of the health problems we are having since installation of the Smart Meter on our house in October, 2017.

Each night, almost always between 3:00 and 3:20 am, I awaken for no apparent reason and then cannot fall back asleep for 1-2 hours. My husband told me he is experiencing the same issue. It's funny that we are both waking at the same time.

The meter is on the outside wall below our bedroom. As a result, we haven't been sleeping in our bedroom since that time. For awhile we were sleeping down in our unheated concrete-floor basement (in sleeping bags) so that we could get a good night's sleep. A pipe broke during the cold weather we just had in January in the basement, soaking all our mattresses and sleeping bags and pillows! So, now I am sleeping in the living room and he is sleeping in another bedroom and just dealing with waking at 3:00 am. Needless to say, he is grouchy and falls asleep almost every night at 7:00 pm!! I need my 8 hours of sleep because I commute an hour one way to my job and without adequate sleep, I find I fall asleep at the wheel. I am extremely fearful of having an accident.

Also, when I am home on my day off on Friday or on the weekend working in the kitchen, I get dull headaches and feel quite disoriented and irritable.

My next-door neighbor, when we chatted recently, mentioned that his wife is waking up during the night, too. A friend at church heard me telling someone that I was experiencing insomnia joined in to share he was waking up during the night, around 3 am. It must be more than a coincidence!! We do not want to continue to live like this. I've called PPL numerous times and they just say the PUC is legally requiring the smart meters and there's nothing they can do.

One other odd thing that may be related is that our electric bill has increased from \$150 in Oct/Nov to \$400 in Dec/Jan. Part of this is the fact that our heat pump was malfunctioning part of that time during the cold streak we had, but I have a feeling some of the increase may be related to the smart meter. I learned from PPL that we have a very powerful smart meter that is transmitting to a receiver about 2 miles away from our home (PPL actually gave me the physical address of the receiving device when I asked.)

We are quite dissatisfied with PPL and PUC infringing on our rights and not giving us the choice to opt out of a smart meter.

**January 21, 2013**

I, Donna Bervinchak, lived in an apartment in San Francisco for 20 years and within four months time of having smart meters installed on the building I was no longer able to work. While in my home, I couldn't think, concentrate or breath. I couldn't eat or sleep and on the last day I spent in my apartment I was on the verge of a breakdown when my friend Eleanor Gomez picked me up and took me to her home that did not have a smart meter.

The first two days I spent in Eleanor's home, I deliriously slept as I was able to breath for the first time since October. I experienced a deep hopelessness that I had never known until I was exposed to the constant microwave radiation pulses that smart meters were emitting into my home.

Smart meters were installed on the apartment building I lived at in October of 2011. Some of the immediate symptoms I developed from them were extreme fatigue, headaches, sleep disorders, anxiety, and difficult memory recall. I broke out in hives on my face in November 2011. In December, I started to get heart palpitations and shortness of breath. By Jan. 29, 2012 I had to move out of my apartment because I was on the verge of a physical, emotional and mental breakdown. On that day I lost my home, my job and livelihood and I questioned my will to live. My friends helped me through a very dark time during the first two days that I stayed with them.

On March 3, 2012 I moved to Lancaster, Pennsylvania the town I grew up in to start my life over again. I am recovering physically, emotionally, mentally and spiritually with the help of family and friends. I have started my business and am fully functional and able to work and support myself once again because there are no smart meters here.

**Update: January 24, 2018**

On July 5th and 6th of 2017 smart meters were installed on buildings in Lancaster, Pennsylvania. On July 10, 2017, I moved out of my office and closed down my business because I could not function in the building that has a multiple number of smart meters on it. In September 2017, I moved into Apartment two on Daneen Kemple's property in order to get farther away from the neighbors' smart meters so I could sleep. I have not worked full time since July 2017 and since September 2017, I have been borrowing money from my family members in order to pay my rent and bills.

When I visit my brothers' home I am only able to spend time in one room that is not directly hit by a neighbors' smart meter. All of the other rooms are in close proximity to neighbors' smart meters and when I am in them I experience the same symptoms that I developed in San Francisco in 2012 when smart meters were installed there.

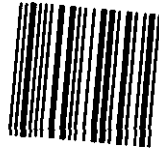
