You were served my first set of interrogatories on February 2, 2018 via email accompanied by an eFile certificate of service. I understand Peco has 20 days to respond, pursuant to § 5.342. (d) It has been 26 days, and I have not yet received any answers to those interrogatories.

**§ 5.342. Answers or objections to written interrogatories by a party.**

(d) *Service of answer.* The answering party shall serve answers on the parties within 15 days for rate proceedings, and 20 days after service of the interrogatories for other cases. Time periods may be modified by the presiding officer, on motion or by agreement of the parties.

It would be preferable that I not need to file a motion to compel. Please respond to my Interrogatories Set I within two days.
