V.F. Transportation, L.L.C. ("Respondent") has paid, in full, its outstanding assessment balance for the July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017 Fiscal Year ("2016-2017 Fiscal Year") and the civil penalty to resolve the above-docketed complaint without litigation.

On February 1, 2018, the Commission received a certified check from Respondent in the amount of \$8,170, which constitutes payment of Respondent's outstanding assessment balance for the 2016-2017 Fiscal Year in the amount of \$4,050, as well as \$1,108 related to the civil penalty for Respondent's failure to timely pay the Commission's assessment and file an assessment report demonstrating its gross intrastate revenues earned during the 2015 calendar year. The remainder of the certified check in the amount of \$3,012 was applied to Respondent's outstanding assessment balance for the July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018 Fiscal Year.

Accordingly, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.24(a), I&E files this letter to certify that the above-docketed proceeding has been satisfied and should be marked closed.
