2. My interest in this project is as a landowner and resident of Lower Chanceford Township York County.
3. My interest as a landowner is not adequately represented by existing participants.
4. Our home property is in the middle of our neighbor's preserved multi-generation family farm. The power lines are proposed to be constructed directly behind our property. If the proposed right-of-way should be built, our property value would diminish significantly. The beautiful view of the sunrise we have loved watching for years would be blighted by large, unsightly power lines. We have lived at the same property for over 20 years. We have invested in our property inside the house, and on our land. We moved here because it is quiet, peaceful, and calm. No power lines are here except the ones that provide power to our home. The proposed lines would not provide us a better rate for our electric.

WHEREFORE, Kimberly Slezak respectfully requests Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to investigate the filing, and strongly impose a condition that all other existing rights of way and infrastructure should be completely utilized before any new power line projects are approved.

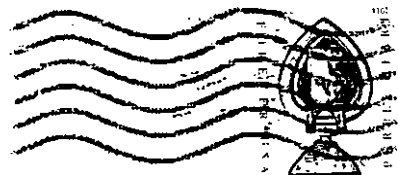
