**MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE OF
PPL ELECTRIC UTILITIES CORPORATION**

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE ELIZABETH H. BARNES:

PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric” or the “Company”) hereby moves to consolidate the above-captioned matters pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.81. The Company is requesting that the proceeding at Docket No. C-2016-2572824 (“Donna Bervinchak Complaint”) be consolidated with the proceeding at Docket No. C-2016-2577527 (“J. Jude Bervinchak Complaint”) for purposes of discovery, hearings, and adjudication because they raise common issues of fact and law.

Due to recent developments, both of these proceedings involve challenges to PPL Electric’s planned installation of a new AMI meter at the same address. Ms. Donna Bervinchak recently notified PPL Electric that she has moved into the residence of Mr. J. Jude Bervinchak at 825 Christine Lane, Lancaster, Pennsylvania 17601. Ms. Bervinchak also no longer has a service account at 3645 Marietta Avenue, Apt. 1, Lancaster, Pennsylvania 17601, which was the service address listed in her Complaint. Therefore, both of these Complaints now concern the

installation of a new AMI meter at the same residence: 825 Christine Lane, Lancaster, Pennsylvania 17601, the residence listed in the J. Jude Bervinchak Complaint. Thus, consolidating these proceedings will promote efficient and consistent administration of justice.

Further, since the hearing in the Donna Bervinchak Complaint matter is scheduled for March 8, 2018, PPL Electric respectfully requests that responsive pleadings to this Motion be filed by March 1, 2018, and that Administrative Law Judge Elizabeth H. Barnes (the “ALJ”) rule on this Motion by March 7, 2018. Moreover, if the instant Motion is granted, the Company respectfully requests that the hearing for both of these Complaints be held on March 23, 2018, so as not to prejudice Mr. J. Jude Bervinchak with an earlier hearing date.

In support of this Motion, PPL Electric states as follows:

I. BACKGROUND

1. PPL Electric furnishes electric distribution, transmission, and default supply services to approximately 1.4 million customers throughout its certificated service territory, which includes all or portions of 29 counties and encompasses approximately 10,000 square miles in eastern and central Pennsylvania. PPL Electric is a “public utility,” an “electric distribution company,” and a “default service provider” as defined in Sections 102 and 2803 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§ 102, 2803.

2. By way of background, the Company deployed automated metering infrastructure (“AMI”) meters and metering system between 2002 and 2004. These AMI meters were a part of a power line carrier (“PLC”) metering system. On November 14, 2008, Act 129 of 2008 became effective and required electric distribution companies (“EDCs”) to file smart meter technology procurement and installation plans with the Commission within nine months. On June 24, 2009, the Commission issued its *Smart Meter Implementation Order*, which set forth requirements for the smart meter plans and procedures for the submission, review, and approval of the smart

meter plans. *See Smart Meter Procurement and Installation*, Docket No. M-2009-2092655 (Order entered June 24, 2009) (“*Smart Meter Implementation Order*”).

3. On August 14, 2009, PPL Electric filed its initial Smart Meter Plan in compliance with Act 129 and the Commission’s *Smart Meter Implementation Order*. The Company contended that its existing PLC system met the requirements under Act 129 and the *Smart Meter Implementation Order*. However, the Commission held that PPL Electric’s existing PLC meters did not fully meet these requirements. *See Petition of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation for Approval of Smart Meter Technology Procurement and Installation Plan*, Docket No. M-2009-2123945, p. 24 (Order entered June 24, 2010) (“*2010 Smart Meter Order*”). Accordingly, the Commission directed PPL Electric to develop a new Smart Meter Plan that would deploy new AMI technology that fully met these requirements. *See id.*

4. On June 30, 2014, PPL Electric filed its new Smart Meter Plan intended to comply with all the requirements of Act 129 and the Commission’s *Smart Meter Implementation Order*. To meet these requirements, the Company proposed Radio Frequency (“RF”) Mesh meters and metering system. These RF Mesh meters were to be deployed between 2017 and 2019. On September 3, 2015, the Commission entered its Opinion and Order approving the new Smart Meter Plan, as modified, finding that unlike the Company’s existing PLC meters, the new RF Mesh meters met the requirements of Act 129 and the Commission’s *Smart Meter Implementation Order*. *Petition of PPL Electric Utilities Corp. for Approval of Its Smart Meter Technology Procurement and Installation Plan*, Docket No. M-2014-2430781 (Order Entered Sept. 3, 2015) (“*2015 Smart Meter Order*”).

5. By Secretarial Letter dated October 26, 2016, PPL Electric was served with the above-captioned Donna Bervinchak Complaint. The issues raised in the Donna Bervinchak

Complaint concern the forthcoming installation of a new AMI meter pursuant to the Public Utility Code and the *2015 Smart Meter Order* at 3645 Marietta Avenue, Apt. 1, Lancaster, Pennsylvania 17601, *i.e.*, Ms. Bervinchak's residence at the time of filing the Complaint.

6. By Secretarial Letter dated November 29, 2016, PPL Electric was served with the above-captioned J. Jude Bervinchak Complaint. The issues raised in the J. Jude Bervinchak Complaint concern the forthcoming installation of a smart meter pursuant to the Public Utility Code and the *2015 Smart Meter Order* at Mr. Bervinchak's residence: 825 Christine Lane, Lancaster, Pennsylvania 17601.

7. On August 22, 2017, Ms. Bervinchak cancelled electric service to Apartment 1 at 3645 Marietta Avenue, Lancaster, Pennsylvania 17601 and started service to Apartment B at 3645 Marietta Avenue, Lancaster, Pennsylvania 17601. True and correct copies of the Company's records of these requests are attached hereto as **Attachment 1**.

8. By letter received on February 12, 2018, Ms. Bervinchak informed PPL Electric and the ALJ that she moved to 825 Christine Lane, Lancaster, Pennsylvania. A true and correct copy of the February 12, 2018 letter is attached hereto as **Attachment 2**.

9. Also on February 12, 2018, PPL Electric received a call from Ms. Daneen Kemple, Ms. Bervinchak's landlord, to start service in Ms. Kemple's name at 3645 Marietta Avenue, Apt. B, Lancaster, Pennsylvania 17601. *See Attachment 1, p. 2.*

10. Ms. Bervinchak no longer resides at the address that is the subject of the Donna Bervinchak Complaint (*i.e.*, 3645 Marietta Avenue, Lancaster, Pennsylvania 17601) and, as of February 13, 2018, no longer has any service account with PPL Electric. As such, Ms. Bervinchak is no longer subject to the AMI meter to be installed at that address.

11. Rather, Ms. Bervinchak now resides at the same address as Mr. Bervinchak (*i.e.*, 825 Christine Lane, Lancaster, Pennsylvania 17601), which will only have one new AMI meter installed (*i.e.*, the smart meter that is already the subject of the J. Jude Bervinchak Complaint).

II. MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE

12. PPL Electric herein respectfully requests that the Donna Bervinchak Complaint proceeding at Docket No. C-2016-2572824 be consolidated with the J. Jude Bervinchak Complaint proceeding at Docket No. C-2016-2577527 for purposes of discovery, litigation, and disposition because they are interrelated and raise common issues of law and fact.

13. In Mr. J. Jude Bervinchak's Complaint, he requests that the Commission order PPL Electric to, among other things, not install a new AMI meter on his residence at 825 Christine Lane, Lancaster, Pennsylvania 17601. (J. Jude Bervinchak Complaint ¶ 5) Alternatively, Mr. Bervinchak requested that a new AMI meter not be installed at 825 Christine Lane, Lancaster, Pennsylvania 17601 until 2019. (J. Jude Bervinchak Complaint ¶ 5)

14. Similarly, in Ms. Donna Bervinchak's Complaint, she requests that the Commission order PPL Electric to, among other things, not install a new AMI meter on her residence at 3645 Marietta Avenue, Lancaster, Pennsylvania 17601. (Donna Bervinchak Complaint ¶ 5)

15. Accordingly, both of these proceedings request similar relief and involve PPL Electric's legal obligation under the Public Utility Code and the Company's Commission-approved Smart Meter Plan and whether the Complainant's are entitled to an "opt-out" of the new AMI meter installation. *See* 66 Pa. C.S. § 2807(f); *2015 Smart Meter Order*.

16. In addition, both of these proceedings now concern the installation of a new AMI meter at the same property. In the letter received February 12, 2018, Ms. Bervinchak indicated that she moved to and now resides at 825 Christine Lane, Lancaster, Pennsylvania. *See*

Attachment 2. Ms. Bervinchak no longer resides at 3645 Marietta Avenue, Lancaster, Pennsylvania 17601 and no longer has any service account with PPL Electric. *See* Attachment 1; Attachment 2. As a result, both proceedings now concern the forthcoming AMI meter installation at the same property—825 Christine Lane, Lancaster, Pennsylvania 17601.¹

17. For these reasons, PPL Electric respectfully requests that these proceedings be consolidated. It would be a waste of administrative and judicial resources to litigate these matters separately when they raise overlapping issues of fact and law. Thus, because the disposition of each of these matters is interrelated, the consolidation of these proceedings will promote the efficient use of the time and resources of the parties and the Commission.

18. PPL Electric further notes that the evidentiary hearing for the Donna Bervinchak Complaint is set for March 8, 2018. Normally parties have 20 days to answer motions under the Commission's regulations. *See* 52 Pa. Code § 5.103(c). However, Ms. Bervinchak's change of address is a very recent development, and the Company maintains that a shortened response period should be adopted in order to facilitate a ruling before the March 8, 2018 hearing. Accordingly, PPL Electric respectfully requests that responsive pleadings to this Motion be filed by March 1, 2018, and that the ALJ rule on this Motion by March 7, 2018.

19. Finally, the hearing for the J. Jude Bervinchak Complaint is scheduled to be held on March 23, 2018. If PPL Electric's Motion to Consolidate is granted, PPL Electric avers it

¹ PPL Electric notes that, as a result of her move, Ms. Bervinchak no longer has standing to contest the future installation of a new AMI meter at the address that was originally the subject of the Donna Bervinchak Complaint: 3645 Marietta Avenue, Lancaster, Pennsylvania 17601. However, PPL Electric recognizes that Ms. Bervinchak is a *pro se* litigant and that she intends to contest the installation of a new AMI meter where she resides, which is now 825 Christine Lane, Lancaster, Pennsylvania 17601. PPL Electric maintains it is efficient to consolidate the proceedings because both Ms. Bervinchak and Mr. Bervinchak now live at the same address. To the extent the ALJ deems any amendment to the pleadings is necessary to reflect the change of address, PPL Electric would not object to Ms. Bervinchak's Complaint being amended to reflect the new address either in advance of or at the evidentiary hearing. *See* 52 Pa. Code § 5.92(a)-(b).

would be prudent to hold the hearing for both cases on March 23, 2018, so as not to prejudice Mr. J. Jude Bervinchak with an earlier hearing date.

III. CONCLUSION

WHEREFORE, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation respectfully requests that Administrative Law Judge Elizabeth H. Barnes enter an order consolidating the Donna Bervinchak Complaint proceeding at Docket No. C-2016-2572824 with the J. Jude Bervinchak Complaint proceeding at Docket No. C-2016-2577527 for purposes of discovery, litigation, and disposition. Moreover, the Company respectfully requests that any Answers to the instant Motion to Consolidate be due on or before March 1, 2018, and the Administrative Law Judge Elizabeth H. Barnes rule on the Motion to Consolidate on or before March 7, 2018.

IT IS ORDERED:
