**RESPONDENT, PECO ENERGY COMPANY'S
MOTION FOR A CONTINUANCE**

PECO Energy Company ("PECO"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby request a continuance of the hearing date scheduled in this matter as follows:

1. An in person hearing for this matter is currently scheduled to take place on Friday, March 9 at 10:00 a.m.
2. In the formal complaint, the Complainant disputes the accuracy of PECO's meter and billing.
3. At the hearing, PECO will present the testimony of High Bill Foreman, Thomas Lerro, who will testify to PECO's commercial meter, the commercial meter multiplier, and a high bill field visit conducted at the Complainant's property.
4. Due to two winter storms that hit PECO's service territory on Friday, March 2 and Wednesday, March 7, a large majority of PECO's employees, including Mr. Lerro have been assigned to storm duty working 16 hour shifts. Mr. Lerro is unavailable on March 9 due to his assignment on storm duty in an important role to restore power to PECO's customers.


5. The testimony of Mr. Lerro is critical to PECO's defense, particularly as he has knowledge of commercial meters and commercial meter multipliers and he is the foreman in charge of the high bill field group that conducted the field investigation.

6. PECO contacted counsel for the Complainant, Timothy N. Welbeck, Esquire to request his position on PECO's continuance request and he has no objection to PECO's continuance request.

7. As PECO's key witness is not available for the hearing date, PECO respectfully requests a continuance of this matter.

8. PECO Energy respectfully requests that the hearing be continued to a further date.


