Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

I am counsel to Windstream Communications, Inc. ("Windstream") in the above-referenced matter and am writing to respectfully request a further continuance of approximately forty-five (45) days of the call-in telephonic hearing presently scheduled for March 23, 2018 before Administrative Law Judge Dunderdale.

The continuance is being sought because the parties believe the matter can be resolved without the need for an evidentiary hearing, but additional time is needed for Windstream to complete the repairs necessary to resolve the Complainant's service issues. If there are no further problems after final testing, the expectation would be for Windstream to file a Certificate of Satisfaction.

The continuance will not unduly delay the matter and, importantly, will conserve the limited resources of the Commission and the parties while furthering the Commission's policy of encouraging settlements.

I discussed the status of the repairs and the proposed continuance with the Complainant by telephone on March 12, 2018, and she has authorized me to state that she has no objection and joins in the request.
