> Application of the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for approval to alter the public at-grade crossings by the installation of automatically operated flashing-light railroad crossing warning signals and gates where Washington Street (DOT #148 849 H), School Street (DOT #148 848 B), Church Street (DOT #148 847 U), Gompers Avenue (DOT #148 846 M), (T-488) Martin Road (DOT #148 830 R) and (T-489) Martin Road (DOT #148 826 B) cross the single track of the Buffalo & Pittsburgh Railroad, Inc., in the White and Rayne Townships, and the Borough of Indiana, Indiana County.

Dear Sir or Madam,

This is to advise that a final inspection of the highway/rail crossings involved in the project detailed above, will be held on Thursday May 3, 2018, beginning at 12:00 noon. All matters involved with the above-captioned proceeding will be discussed. The meeting will convene at the crossing (DOT 148 826 B) where T-489 (Martin Road) crosses, at grade, the track of Buffalo & Pittsburgh Railroad located in Rayne Township, Indiana County and proceed to White Township followed by Indiana Borough.

The purpose of the meeting is to determine the acceptability of the completed work as it pertains to the Commission's Secretarial letter.

If you are unable to attend the final inspection and have additional issues for the Commission to consider, and/or are seeking reimbursement for any costs incurred by the project, you must inform the Commission in writing within twenty (20) days from the date of this letter.
