My name is Hamed Babai, CEO and founder of Power Kiosk. We are the previous holder of electricity broker license ~~A-2014-2435574~~

Background:

By Order entered November 13, 2014 at this docket, the Commission issued to Power Kiosk an EGS license as a broker/marketer. This Order also approved Power Kiosk's request for reduced bonding amount of \$10,000. By Tentative Order entered January 26, 2017 (Tentative Order), the Commission tentatively cancelled Power Kiosk's License as an EGS as a broker/marketer for failure to comply with 52 Pa. Code § 54.40(a) and (d) which require EGS licensees to provide a bond or other financial security as required by Section 2809 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §2809.

Power Kiosk filed an appeal in April of 2018 with reasons that it has tried numerous times to communicate and fix the issue. Unfortunately the appeal was rejected after almost a year delay which has brought us to a situation where:

- 1- Power Kiosk has lost 1 year of business time
- 2- Power Kiosk is forced to spend \$4000 to reapply for license.

Considering these business damages, which we agree is partially our fault and will not be repeated any longer, we would like to stop further delay and have our application expedited and reviewed at the first upcoming meeting of PUC.

A-2014-2435574 was cancelled by PUC. Broker appealed the decision and PUC did not answer to the appeal for one full year. PUC finally answered to the appeal and rejected it. Broker has sent numerous complainant to Rosemary Chiavetta office for delays and mistakes of PUC attorneys. There were errors in the decision letters sent to Power Kiosk in February of 2018.

**ORDER**

**I. INTRODUCTION**


On November 12, 2013, NRG Kiosk LLC ("Applicant") filed a verified application with the Illinois Commerce Commission ("Commission") requesting a certificate of service authority to operate as an agent, broker, or consultant ("ABC") in Illinois pursuant to Section 16-115C of the Public Utilities Act ("Act"), 220 ILCS 5/1-101 et seq., and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 454, "Licensure of Retail Electric Agents, Brokers and Consultants" ("Part 454"). Applicant requests authority to offer services as an ABC for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply for third parties in the State of Illinois. Upon review of the application, Staff of the Commission ("Staff") requested additional information and clarification of certain matters. On January 27, 2014, Applicant filed a verified Addendum. Since all of the information to grant the requested relief was contained in the application, the Hearing was waived.

**II. REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL APPLICANTS UNDER SECTION 16-115C OF THE ACT**

Applicant is a business organized under the laws of and authorized to transact business in the State of Illinois. Applicant has certified that it will comply with all applicable regulations; that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements established by Commission rule; that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements pursuant to Section 16-115C of the Act; and that it will comply with all other applicable laws, regulations, terms, and conditions required to the extent they have application to the services being offered by an ABC. Applicant has agreed to ensure that any person who acts on its behalf will comply with all applicable sections of Part 454. Applicant agrees that it will remain in compliance with the provisions of the Act and Part 454, and will ensure that authorizations received from customers, and all other applicable records are retained for a period of not less than three calendar years after the calendar year in which they were created. 

- **Reports of Gross Receipts:** Applicant shall report its Pennsylvania intrastate gross receipts to the Commission on a quarterly and year to date basis no later than 30 days following the end of the quarter.

- The Treasurer or other appropriate officer of Applicant shall transmit to the Department of Revenue by March 15, an annual report, and under oath or affirmation, of the amount of gross receipts received by Applicant during the prior calendar year.
- Net Metering Reports: Applicant shall be responsible to report any Net Metering per the Standards on [http://www.puc.pa.gov/consumer\\_info/electricity/alternative\\_energy.aspx](http://www.puc.pa.gov/consumer_info/electricity/alternative_energy.aspx). Scroll down to the Net Metering Standards Section.
- Applicant shall report to the Commission the percentages of total electricity supplied by each fuel source on an annual basis per 52 Pa. Code § 54.39(d).
- Applicant will be required to meet periodic reporting requirements as may be issued by the Commission to fulfill the Commission's duty under Chapter 28 pertaining to reliability and to inform the Governor and Legislature of the progress of the transition to a fully competitive electric market.

- d. **TRANSFER OF LICENSE:** The Applicant understands that if it plans to transfer its license to another entity, it is required to request authority from the Commission for permission prior to transferring the license. See 66 Pa. C.S. Section 2809(D). Transferee will be required to file the appropriate licensing application.

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Prior to doing business in an EDC service territory, all EGS suppliers, and any broker/marketers that wish to use the Electronic Data Interchange (EDI), must meet the EDI certification requirements of the EDC. Certification is a testing process using the Commission approved Internet protocol. To initiate this process, the EGS is encouraged to contact the EDC as early as possible after filing an application for a license with the Commission, since certification may require as many as four months to complete and customer service contract dates may not commence prior to certification. EDC requirements of new suppliers may be found on the respective EDC home web page. Pennsylvania's industry stakeholder group the Electronic Data Exchange Working Group (EDEWG) develops and maintains the EDI transactions and related business practices, which are found on the Pa. PUC website at [http://www.puc.pa.gov/filing\\_resources/issues\\_laws\\_regulations/electronic\\_data\\_exchange.aspx](http://www.puc.pa.gov/filing_resources/issues_laws_regulations/electronic_data_exchange.aspx). The EDEWG meets telephonically the first Thursday of each month at 2:00pm ET to discuss EDI change control requests and other issues.

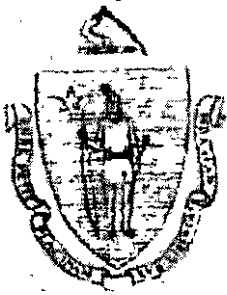

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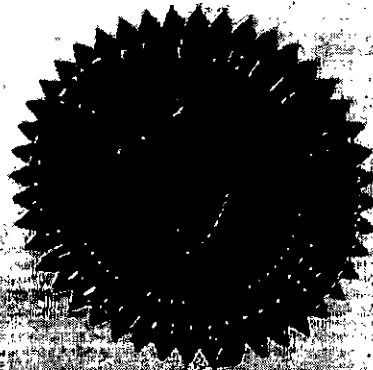

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ORDER

By the Commission:

**I. INTRODUCTION**

On November 12, 2013, NRG Kiosk LLC ("Applicant") filed a verified application with the Illinois Commerce Commission ("Commission") requesting a certificate of service authority to operate as an agent, broker, or consultant ("ABC") in Illinois pursuant to Section 16-115C of the Public Utilities Act ("Act"), 220 ILCS 5/1-101 et seq., and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 454, "Licensure of Retail Electric Agents, Brokers and Consultants" ("Part 454"). Applicant requests authority to offer services as an ABC for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply for third parties in the State of Illinois. Upon review of the application, Staff of the Commission ("Staff") requested additional information and clarification of certain matters. On January 27, 2014, Applicant filed a verified Addendum. Since all of the information to grant the requested relief was contained in the application, the Hearing was waived.

**II. REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL APPLICANTS UNDER SECTION 16-115C OF THE ACT**

Applicant is a business organized under the laws of and authorized to transact business in the State of Illinois. Applicant has certified that it will comply with all applicable regulations; that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements established by Commission rule; that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements pursuant to Section 16-115C of the Act; and that it will comply with all other applicable laws, regulations, terms, and conditions required to the extent they have application to the services being offered by an ABC. Applicant has agreed to ensure that any person who acts on its behalf will comply with all applicable sections of Part 454. Applicant agrees that it will remain in compliance with the provisions of the Act and Part 454, and will ensure that authorizations received from customers, and all other applicable records are retained for a period of not less than three calendar years after the calendar year in which they were created. Applicant has agreed to adopt and follow rules and procedures to preserve the confidentiality of its customers' data. The Applicant has also attested that no complaints have been filed against it for its provision

of services in the electric or gas industry in the jurisdictions where it provides or is seeking to provide services.

### **III. FINANCIAL, TECHNICAL, AND MANAGERIAL REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 16-115C**

Applicant is required by Section 454.60 to demonstrate that it meets the managerial qualifications necessary to provide services as an ABC. Applicant must further provide an organizational chart that indicates the position of persons which satisfy the managerial qualification. Applicant has demonstrated that it meets the managerial qualifications set forth in Section 454.60 through Attachment A. Attachment A contains a corporate organizational chart and identifies the occupational background information of the persons being used to meet the requirements of Section 454.60(a). Attachment A contains occupational background information of the persons being used to meet the requirements of Section 454.60(a).

Applicant is required by Section 454.70 to demonstrate that it meets the technical qualifications necessary to provide services as an ABC. Applicant has demonstrated that it meets the technical qualifications set forth in Section 454.70 with the information provided in Attachment A. Attachment A contains occupational background information on the person or persons being used to meet the requirements of Section 454.70(a).

Pursuant to the requirements of Section 454.80 of Part 454, Applicant provided a surety bond in the amount of \$5,000 issued by a qualifying surety authorized to transact business in Illinois. Applicant further agrees to comply with the Code of Conduct for ABCs contained in Section 454.90.

### **IV. COMMISSION CONCLUSION AND CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY**

The Commission has reviewed the application and attachments along with the supplementary information provided by Applicant regarding the technical, managerial, and financial requirements and all other requirements of the Act and Part 454 and finds that the Applicant sufficiently demonstrates compliance with the requirements. The Commission concludes, therefore, that Applicant's request for a certificate of service authority to operate as an ABC in Illinois should be granted and should include the following authority:

#### CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

IT IS CERTIFIED that NRG Kiosk LLC is granted service authority to operate as an agent, broker, or consultant for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply for third parties in the State of Illinois.

### **V. FINDINGS AND ORDERING PARAGRAPHS**

The Commission, having reviewed the entire record, is of the opinion and finds that:

- (1) NRG Kiosk LLC, a business organized under as well as authorized to transact business in Illinois, seeks a certificate of service authority to operate as an ABC under Section 16-115C of the Act;
- (2) the Commission has jurisdiction over the party hereto and the subject matter hereof;
- (3) the recitals of fact and conclusions reached in the prefatory portion of this Order are supported by the record and are hereby adopted as findings of fact;
- (4) NRG Kiosk LLC has demonstrated that it possesses sufficient financial, managerial, and technical resources and abilities to provide services as an ABC for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply to third parties in the State of Illinois;
- (5) NRG Kiosk LLC has complied with Section 16-115C of the Act and Part 454; and
- (6) NRG Kiosk LLC should be granted a certificate of service authority to operate as an ABC as specified in this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Illinois Commerce Commission that NRG Kiosk LLC is hereby granted a Certificate of Service Authority authorizing it to operate as an agent, broker, or consultant; said Certificate of Service Authority shall read as that set forth in Section IV of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that NRG Kiosk LLC shall comply with all applicable Commission rules and orders now and as hereafter amended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, subject to the provisions of Section 10-113 of the Public Utilities Act and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 200.880, this Order is final; it is not subject to the Administrative Review Law.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

1. By this Order, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia ("Commission") grants a license to NRG Kiosk LLC d/b/a Power Kiosk LLC ("NRG Kiosk" or "Applicant") to function as an electricity supplier in the District of Columbia.<sup>1</sup> The license for NRG Kiosk LLC d/b/a Power Kiosk LLC is effective upon issuance of this Order.

**II. BACKGROUND**

2. On January 23, 2015, NRG Kiosk filed its license application.<sup>2</sup> Specifically, NRG Kiosk intends to operate as a broker/aggregator of electricity for residential, commercial and industrial customers in the District of Columbia, pursuant to Section 34-1505 of the "Retail Electric Competition and Consumer Protection Act of 1999 ("Act")."<sup>3</sup> Pursuant to the Commission's licensing requirements as set forth in Order No. 11796,<sup>4</sup> NRG Kiosk has provided the following information:

- a) Proof of technical and managerial competence;
- b) An affidavit of compliance with applicable Federal and District of Columbia environmental laws and regulations dated January 20, 2015;

- c) Proof of financial integrity to include financial statements;
- d) Proof that NRG Kiosk has registered with the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs to do business in the District of Columbia;
- e) An affidavit dated January 20, 2015, stating that NRG Kiosk is subject to all applicable taxes;
- f) An affidavit dated January 20, 2015, stating that NRG Kiosk will comply with all the requirements of all orders and regulations of the Commission; and
- g) Applicant's website address: <http://www.powerkiosk.com>.

NRG Kiosk filed supplemental financial information on April 2 and April 21, 2015.<sup>5</sup>

### III. DISCUSSION

3. Our review of the information contained in NRG Kiosk's application, demonstrates that it has met all the prescribed licensing requirements and that the Applicant has the ability and the financial integrity to serve electricity customers in the District of Columbia. The Commission also finds that granting NRG Kiosk's application will serve the public interest. Accordingly NRG Kiosk's application is approved.

#### **THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

4. The application of NRG Kiosk LLC d/b/a Power Kiosk LLC for a license to conduct business in the District of Columbia as an electricity supplier is hereby **GRANTED**. The license for NRG Kiosk LLC d/b/a Power Kiosk LLC is effective upon issuance of this Order.

**Summary of Filing:**

On June 5, 2014, Kiosk filed an application for a license to supply electricity or electric generation services in Maryland, limited to broker services. At its Administrative Meeting on July 23, 2014, the Commission deferred action on the request.

**Applicable Law:**

Section 7-507 of the Public Utilities Article ("PUA") of the Annotated Code of Maryland requires that a person be licensed by the Commission in order to engage in business as an electricity supplier. The applicant for such a license must prove technical and managerial competence, financial integrity, compliance with all applicable requirements of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission and the appropriate regional transmission operator and provide certification of compliance with applicable federal and State environmental laws and regulations relating to the generation of electricity (PUA §7-507(b) and (c)). The applicant must provide proof that it is qualified to do business in the State with the Department of Assessments and Taxation, and must agree to be subject to all applicable taxes. The Commission also examines the applicant's compliance with the laws governing energy suppliers in other States in which the applicant serves as a supplier. Specific methods of proving financial integrity are set forth in COMAR 20.51.02.

**Background:**

At its Administrative Meeting on July 23, 2014, the Commission deferred action on the request by NRG Kiosk, doing business as Power Kiosk (referred to here as Kiosk), for authorization from the Maryland PSC to serve as an electricity broker in Maryland. The commissioners expressed concern that Kiosk's use of the name "NRG Kiosk" might mislead Kiosk's customers into believing that there is an affiliation between NRG Energy and Kiosk in connection with Kiosk's brokering activities, which might mean that NRG Energy will back-up Kiosk's contractual commitments to its customers.

Kiosk is registered with the Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation ("SDAT") as Power Kiosk, LLC, a/k/a NRG Kiosk. Kiosk explained to Staff that in choosing the name NRG Kiosk, Kiosk was not aware that there was an existing company named NRG Energy:

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We honestly name[d] [our company NRG Kiosk] not even knowing of NRG Energy. Later we realized that the name is trademarked and we haven't used the name NRG Kiosk at all.

In its comments filed at the Commission on July 21, 2014, the Office of People's Counsel ("OPC") stated that NRG Energy's senior regulatory counsel Abraham Silverman told OPC that "NRG Kiosk was licensed by NRG Energy to use the name NRG in association with the term Kiosk, but otherwise had no other affiliation with the company." NRG Energy stated that once it realized that Kiosk was using "NRG" as part of its name, NRG Energy decided to authorize Kiosk to use this name, on the condition that Kiosk not use the name "NRG" in its communications with the public:

As I understand it, all we could do [once we discovered that Kiosk was using "NRG" as part of its name] was to enter into an agreement with [Kiosk] that they would not use the "NRG" portion of their name when interfacing with the public. So we have no control over what they call themselves, so long as they aren't out in the market using the NRG name.

NRG Energy explained to Staff that "we have no relationship whatsoever with [Kiosk] – they are completely unrelated to NRG [Energy].

Kiosk said that it will not use the name NRG Kiosk in its marketing or contract materials, or in its communications with customers:

We registered the company as an LLC in Illinois as NRG Kiosk. In one month we got a dba for Power Kiosk and since then have been using [the name] Power Kiosk everywhere. Customers will never see the name NRG Kiosk. There is [sic] no marketing materials, websites and customer facing pages/docs with NRG Kiosk name. [NRG Kiosk] is our back-end legal name. We are not going to talk about NRG Kiosk in any of our documents given we are not even using that name.

**Analysis:**

As noted, Kiosk said that it will not use the name NRG Kiosk in its marketing or contract materials, or in its communications with customers. Therefore, Staff

recommends that Kiosk's authorization to operate as a broker reflect this commitment by Kiosk by including a condition that prohibits Kiosk from using the name NRG Kiosk in Kiosk's marketing or contract materials, or in Kiosk's communications with customers. With this condition, Staff believes that the fact that Kiosk's legal name is NRG Kiosk will not mislead customers into believing that (1) Kiosk is affiliated with NRG Energy, or (2) NRG Energy is in any way involved with Kiosk's operations or management.
