Verde Energy USA, Inc. ("Verde") was issued an electric generation supplier license by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") as a result of a final decision issued on March 25, 2010 in Docket No. A-2012-2151038.

In accordance with the Commission's Order entered July 24, 2014 at Docket No. M-2013-2393141, Verde respectfully submits the enclosed bond reduction renewal petition to support maintenance of its bonding amount at the 5% approved by the Commission on May 13th, 2015.




