COMPLAINANT'S OBJECTIONS TO RESPONDENT'S PETITION FOR LEAVE TO
WITHDRAW PHILADELPHIA GAS WORKS' MOTION TO DISMISS ANY
FUTHER EXCEPTIONS AS UNTIMELY

The Complainant objects to PGW's Petition for Leave to Withdraw Respondent's Motion to Dismiss any Further Exceptions as Untimely. The Complainant did **TIMELY** filed her Full Exceptions on March 22, 2018, as directed.

The Respondents had already did their harm, distress, duress, undo hardship, and etc... upon the Complainant by filing this false and premature Petition to Dismiss the Complainant's Exceptions.

Just like when the Respondent's filed their Reply Exceptions, it was not on the Commission's Docket on the day that it was due; however, days later it was added with a corrected date, since it was deemed received as timely. Therefore, Ms. Christlieb knows that if the document is postmarked on the day that it is due, it is considered timely.

According to the Pennsylvania's Public Utility Commission, as long as the document for the Commission is postmarked on the day that is it due or if it is hand delivered to the PUC in Harrisburg before 12 noon the following day, the document will be accepted as timely. Therefore, the Complainant did not "failed to" meet the granted ten extension deadline on March 22, 2018 as Ms. Christlieb so falsified.

The 22nd of March landed on Friday, and the Complainant had also emailed her on the 23rd of March, 2018, with a copy of her Exceptions along with the attachments/exhibits, and forethought and malice, she filed her Motion to Dismiss on a Saturday, March 23, 2018; without, waiting to see the copies that were awaiting delivery by the Postal Service. Therefore, as the Complainant had stated as well as proved that a copy of her Exceptions where sent on due date, and received timely by the PPUC.

Most recently, the Complainant filed a Supplemental Document on the record that was not placed on the Docket for almost about two weeks; whereas, it was received about two days after it was mailed via Certified Mailing, but they corrected the date of filing based off of when it was received. Thus, Ms. Chistlieb knew or should have known that the Complainant's Exceptions could not be considered late, until it was signified by the Commission. The Complainant has asked for several sanctions against PGW and it's Attorney, Ms. Christlieb, and the Judges in this case continues to refused to sanction PGW, and it's Attorney for their tactics, violations, and etc...! Complainant is still seeking sanctions against PGW and it's Attorney, and is expecting order.

WHEREFORE, since the Complainant's Exceptions were timely file, the Complainant is still seeking sanctions against the Philadelphia Gas Works and it Attorney, Ms. Graciela Christlieb.
