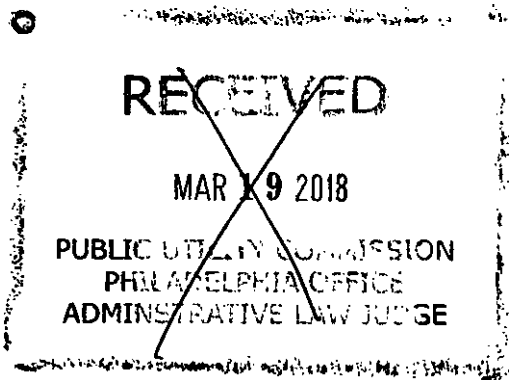

Dear Judge Heep, Your Honor:

This is in reply to the PECO/Smith "PECO ENERGY CO's Objection to Petition to Withdraw, Unless Material Conditions Are Placed upon the Withdrawal."

On page 61 of Attorney Ward Smith's exhibits in the above, there is a copy of my letter to PA PUC Secretary Rosemary Chiavetta acknowledging her phone call to me (*she called me!*) **recommending that I refile my formal smart meter complaint against PECO** after I received a threatening 72-hour shut-off notice from PECO.

**I followed the instructions of the PA PUC Secretary herself** and now I'm being "prosecuted" for doing so. The Secretary's advice is why I submitted the complaint.

The pertinent reasons for my declining and objecting to an AMI Smart Meter, **which radiates gigahertz (GHz) microwaves into a residence or building so retrofitted**, is the fact I have had two strokes and suffer from high blood pressure. Ward Smith's objections to my removing myself from this case adds unwanted and unwarranted stresses to my life, which my physicians advise I have to avoid.

PECO/Smith cannot aggravate me to the point of causing me another stroke by negatively interfering with my high blood pressure. If that happens, I will have no recourse but to sue Attorney Smith individually and as a PECO employee, PECO, Secretary Chiavetta, and the PA PUC. PECO cannot make me sick nor cause me to suffer another stroke. I consider PECO's treatment to be harassment and bullying, which are prosecutable crimes, and which members of the legal profession should be fully knowledgeable and not engage.

I respectfully remind this Court and bring to its attention the unfortunate fact numerous PECO utility customers have filed formal complaints citing health reasons. Some cases include:
