

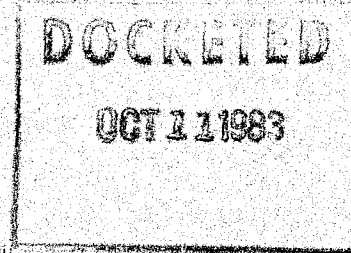


Dear Sir:

The Commission, in a public meeting on September 30, 1983, acted to accept Supplement No. 6 to Tariff Electric-PA P.U.C. No. 199 which was filed in response to Commission order dated August 19, 1983. Therefore, Supplement No. 6 to Tariff Electric-PA P.U.C. No. 199 becomes effective for service rendered on and after August 22, 1983, and our investigation at R-822169 is hereby terminated.

The Commission has further action to deny the allegations contained in the Petition filed by Lehigh Valley Power Committee on September 6, 1983, as pertains to the application of the compliance filing as contained in Supplement No. 6 to Tariff Electric-PA P.U.C.
