Q.1 Reference the Municipal Agreement, Paragraph 7, please state the meaning of “other good and valuable consideration” and explain the methodology used to determine it.

A.1 In this matter PPL charged Crestwood School District \$1,000 for PPL engineering review, documentation and filing fees to their encroachment request for proposed improvements to be located within PPL ROW corridors to prevent these costs from being passed along to other customers.

In this instance PPL receives a non-monetary benefit of goodwill in being able to accommodate the School District’s encroachment request. This is what is meant by other good and valuable consideration in this agreement. The existence of consideration, or that an agreement is mutually beneficial, is a pre-requisite for an agreement to be legally enforceable. That is why the phrase “other good and valuable consideration” is included as a vital part of many agreements.
